Discussions items,

Captains will decide on team size for each tournament. It was decided that 6 players would probably be the maximum that could play a tournament effectively and 3 would probably be the minimum.

There was some discussion on whether the teams needed to be the same size and was decided that they need not. We will start our tournaments with this in mind and see how it works.

Playing location was discussed again, and decided that the team captains may elect to play at either location or a mutually agree upon location, such as Tucson Armory or Sierra Vista providing the facility is available and confirmed by the alternate locations team captain.

There was discussion on whether this competition should be mainly for fun or competition and the decision was reaffirmed that we want to all clubs to have as much fun as possible.

There was further discussion on having "A" and "B" teams. It was decided that if there was enough players to have two teams that we would try to accommodate all players. The "A" team would be for scoring and team wins towards the "CUP" and that the "B" team could be for scoring or might not depending on the decisions of the team captains and desires of the team members.

There was discussion around simplifying the scoring sheets and the schedule.
