Day passes Pricing

Four types of guest passes are available:

One Day Pass for \$8.00;

Five Day Pass for \$36.00;

Ten Day Pass for \$58.00;

Twenty Day Pass for \$88.00

Five, ten and twenty day passes are not consecutive days passes. All guest passes will expire one year from the date of purchase. Any unused days remaining on the guest pass (temporary card) will be voided on the expiration date. Passes are purchased at Recreation Services (lobby area). Payment may be made by cash, check, debit, American Express, Visa, or MasterCard.

Day passes Policy

Current Campus Recreation members may sponsor guests at any time. The member must accompany their guest at time of guest pass purchase. The guest accepts the terms and conditions stated in the (AOR) Assumption of Risk and Personal Responsibility User Agreement for guests that is completed and signed at time of purchase.

A guest purchasing a ten day guest pass would receive a temporary card. Imprinted on this card is the name of the guest purchasing and the number of days purchased. When the guest comes in to use a day on a guest pass, the temporary card is presented at check in and a picture ID is shown to verify the name on the guest account. As the card is swiped, Rec database automatically removes one day of use from the pass until all days purchased are used and/or the card is expired – whichever comes first. Guest passes are non-refundable and non-transferable and, as such, can only be used by the person named on the Temporary Card. The person named on the Temporary Card must be the same person that signs our guest AOR agreement at time of purchase.
